


MailOne no label printer setup


Start - search - type in "regedit" hit <Enter>.

Select "Yes" on User Account Control dialog box.

Go to HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows NT\CurrentVersion\Ports




Right click on right side of form and **New - Key - String Value.**



Name it "MailOnePrintFile".


Double click on the new key and edit the new path.




Restart the computer for the new port to take effect.

Add a new printer - **Start - Devices and Printers.**


Add a printer




Local printer




Select the "**MailOnePrintFile**" - next.




Select Generic and Generic/Text Only - Next.





If you see this - Next.
